We believe that the Father sent Jesus, the Son, to earth to pay the penalty for sin and that faith in Jesus is the only way to have and experience a personal relationship with God.

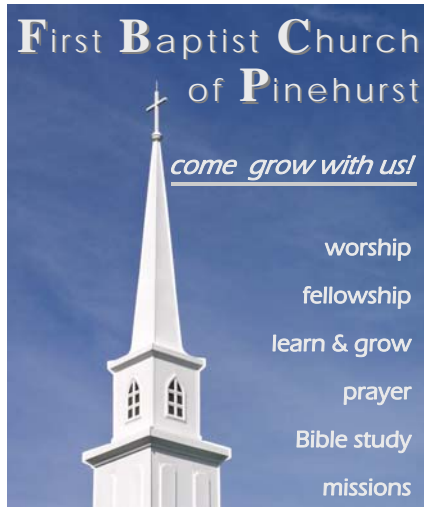
We believe God has created heaven as our eternal home and all those who have accepted Jesus as Lord will dwell with Him there for eternity.

## CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS



We believe that children are God's gift to us to nurture and train up in the way of our Lord. We offer several programs and activities to help our children grow to know and love the Lord.

During Sunday worship, children ages 3-5 are invited to a separate activity based Bible study, led by 2-3 adult volunteers. On Sunday evenings at 6:00pm we have Preschool Choir (ages 3-6), and Children's Choir (Grades 1-3), and special programs such as Bible Skills and Thrills (Grades 4-6).

On Wednesday evenings at 7:00pm we have Mission Friends (ages 3-5), Royal Ambassadors Boys (Grades 1-6), and Girls In Action (Girls Grades 1-6).

A Nursery Is Provided For Babies-2 year olds during all of these activities. Also, during the summer we offer a host of special activities including Vacation Bible School and Terrific Tuesdays (9:00 -11:00am featuring a different Bible Story Movie, snack and activities).

## DISCIPLESHIP & MISSIONS



**Discipleship Training:** We offer additional Bible study courses for those interested in furthering their spiritual growth. These include small study groups talking and discussing Biblical teachings that deal with life issues. Many of these groups last from 6-12 weeks with personal workbooks to guide individual study through the week.

**Mission Opportunities:** Our women's organization (WMU) is involved in several mission endeavors throughout the year. Our men are a part of the North Carolina Baptist Men's Disaster Relief Program. We have taken a number of our people on several trips to areas hit by natural disasters.
