Action Guidelines and Expectations
2009-10

All youth and adults are expected to display a positive, Christ-like attitude that is respectful and loving. These guidelines are not meant to make youth activities and church seem legalistic; but are meant to provide a secure, stable environment for all involved.

1. Youth and adults are expected to be respectful to each other and others not in our group.
2. All youth are expected to be respectful to church property and each other's property.
3. There will be no hitting or fighting during any youth activities.
4. All youth are to display an attitude of worship during any church service.
5. Possession of and or use of tobacco products, alcohol, drug, pornography, or profanity are not allowed by youth or adults during youth activities on or off church property.
6. Clothing must represent a good moral attitude. (See Following Page For Dress Conduct)
7. Public displays of affection are not permitted among unmarried couples.
8. Two youth of the opposite sex are not to be alone in a room during youth activities.
9. Music, video, pictures and games that contain profanity, sex, violence or evil are not permitted.
10. Everyone must ride as a group in provided transportation unless prior arrangements have been made.
11. If you invite a guest to any youth activities you are responsible for making sure your guest knows and understands these rules.

Our goal as a youth ministry is for Christ to be the center of all that we do. Honoring Christ with our words and actions will always be our focus.
